- A copy of your insurance must be provided before filming can take place.
- You must provide a completed risk assessment and method statement at least 48 hours before filming. If filming involves children, specific consideration will need to be given to this within the risk assessment.
- All equipment <u>must</u> be battery powered as there are no power sockets available for use in the attraction.

- The use of flash photography is forbidden for animal welfare reasons. Constant light sources (for example, battery powered LED light banks) are permitted if prior permission is sought. No changes can be made to the existing lighting in the attraction.
- All crew must enter and exit the building together when filming outside opening hours.
 For security reasons there is no way for latecomers to enter the building once a shoot is underway, or for some crew members to exit the building without the rest of their party.
